NOTICE ABOUT THE WRITTEN EXAM

- 1) **Read** carefully the text **before** starting to write
- 2) **ask** clarification if you have any doubt
- 3) **separate** the two **problems** writing them on separate sheets of paper
- 4) on **every sheet**: **SURNAME, NAME** and Polimi identification number
- 5) on **every** face: **page number**
- 6) write well-ordered and clearly readable
Default: **not** well readable = **NOT written**.
- 7) Have special attention where an **explanation** is requested.
Default: result reported **without** explanation = **NO** answer.
- 8) Have special attention where a **quantitative** result is requested
Default: quantitative statement **not given** = **response NOT given**.
- 9) If you deem that the written text that you have delivered is sufficient or almost sufficient for the exam, communicate that you want it be evaluated.
Default: **NO communication = evaluation NOT wanted**.

Your communication has to be done by email message as follows:

- with **subject**: “**YES EVALUATION, Surname & Name**”
- sent at two addresses: sergio.cova@polimi.it, ivan.rech@polimi.it
- within the term written on the blackboard in the exam classroom

If you deem that the written text that you have delivered is categorically NOT sufficient, we invite you to avoid asking its evaluation.

You can **in any case** ask to the teacher a consultation for reviewing your written text and asking clarifications and explanations.

A written answer of level much lower than sufficient can be classified “Rejected” (Riprovato), bearing consequences according to the official rules.
